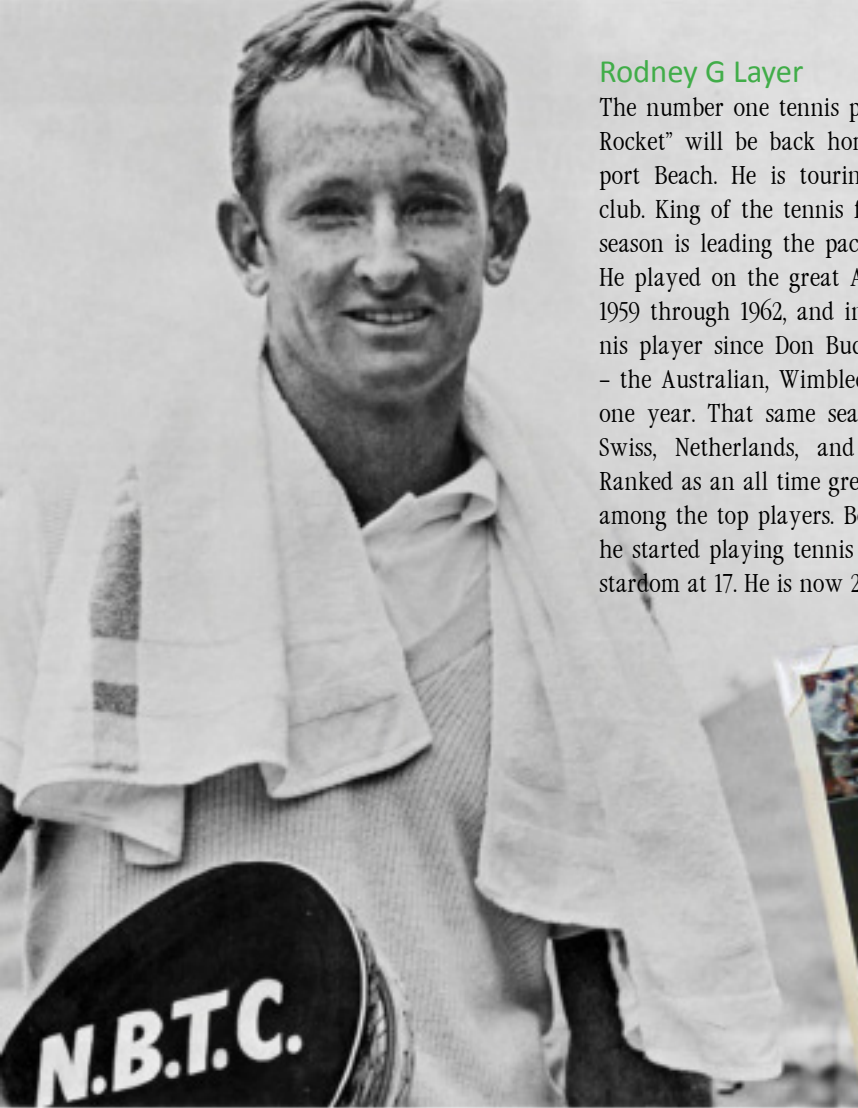

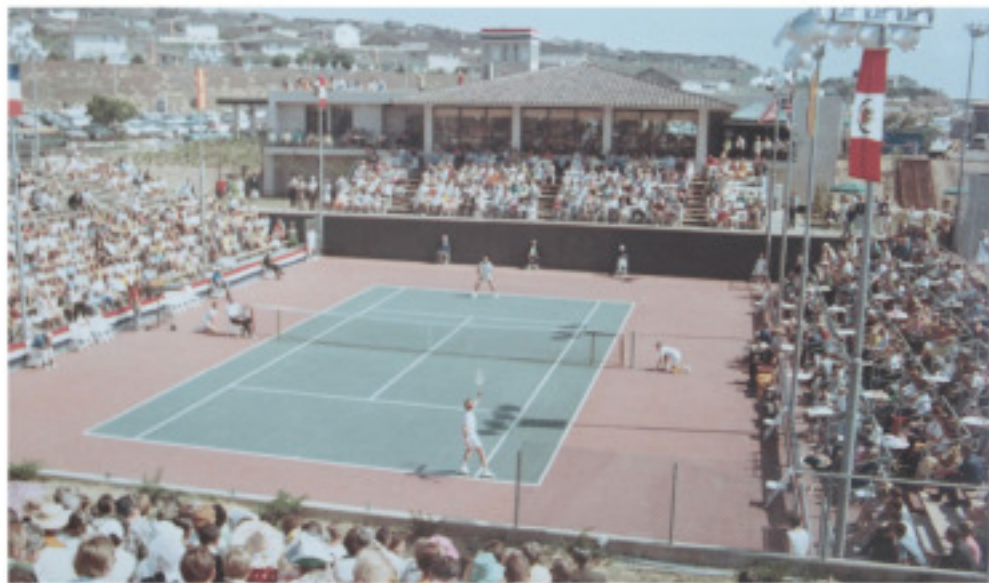

The number one tennis player in the world, “Rod the Rocket” will be back home” when he plays at Newport Beach. He is touring professional for the host club. King of the tennis for the past three years, this season is leading the pack again in wins – and cash. He played on the great Aussie Davis Cup teams from 1959 through 1962, and in 1962 became the “first tennis player since Don Budge to win the “grand slam” – the Australian, Wimbledon French, and U.S. titles in one year. That same season he captured the Italian, Swiss, Netherlands, and Norwegian championships. Ranked as an all time great, he is the only left-hander among the top players. Born in Queensland, Australia, he started playing tennis at an early age and reached stardom at 17. He is now 28.

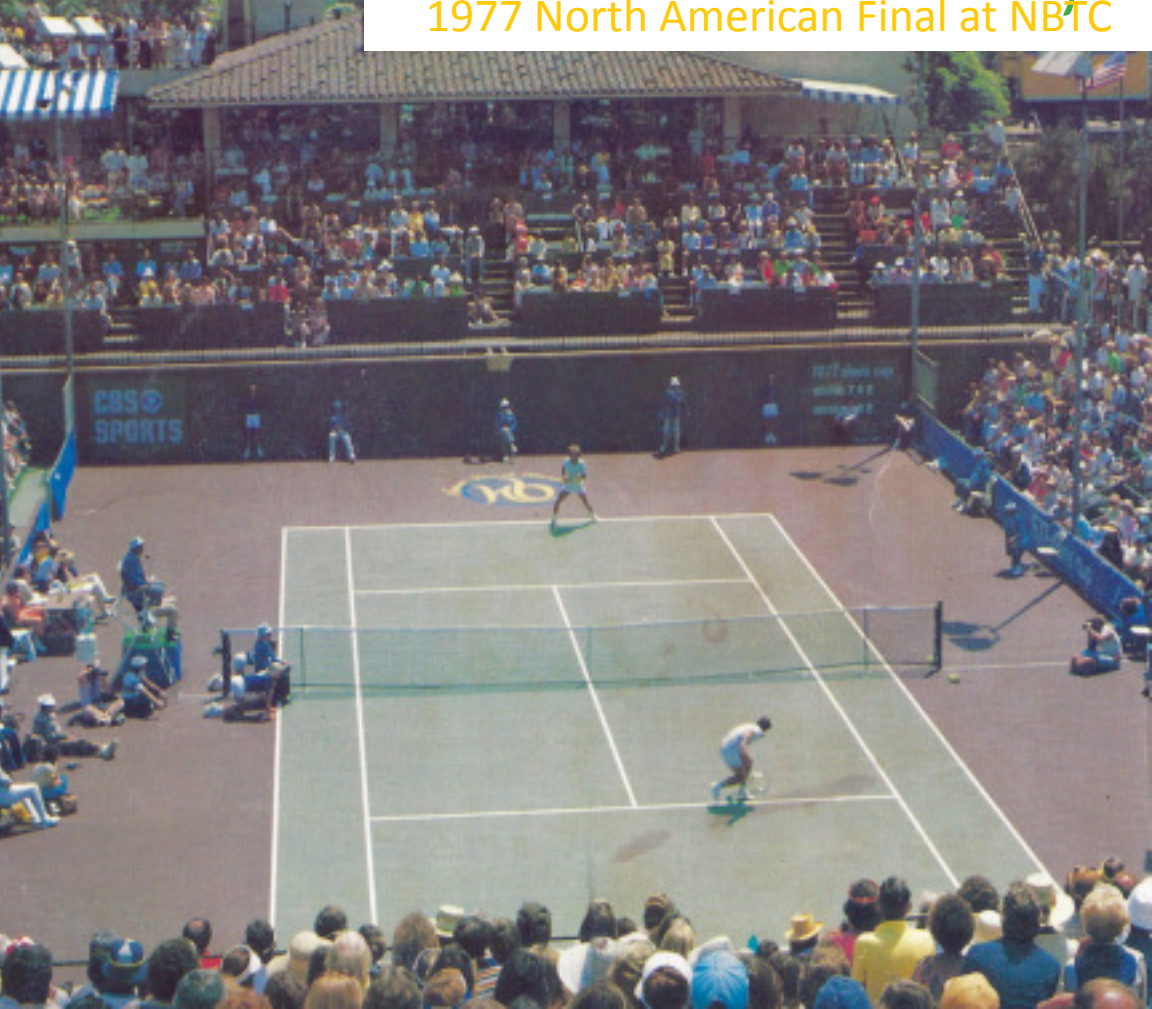

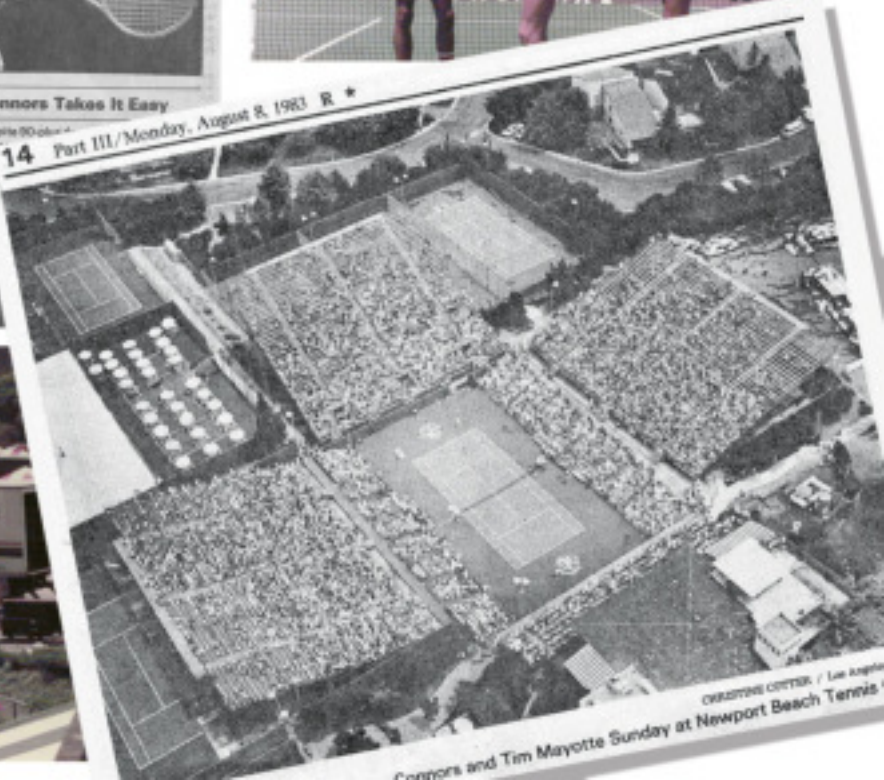
